8. Hadriel constantly says he's mediocre—but do you believe that's true? Or is he more powerful than he lets on?

10. When Weston and Nyfain hold each other accountable as the kingdom's most powerful beings, what does that say about power, friendship, and responsibility?

11. Hannon and Dessia... do you think they might be mates? And if their story were a Deliciously Dark Fairy Tale, which one would it be?
