## The Dirty Dozen

### Foreplay - Warm Up Questions

1. What's the overall spice level? 1 (Not Spicy) - 10 (Spiciest Thing I've Ever Read)?
2. How does the spice level compare to the other books we've read together?
3. Be honest: if you inherited millions and a mafia empire at 23, would you step up like Alessa... or peace out with a passport and a fake identity? Is the power worth the pressure?

### The Spicy Bits - Gettin' Down and Dirty with the Plot

4. Let's talk vigilante justice: badass or dangerous? When it's personal and the system fails, is it revenge... or justice?
5. Alessa has reasons for her kills as the Black Demon. She has *targets*. Does that make her a heroine or just another killer? Where's your moral line when the blood starts spilling?
6. Ryder's told: *commit or quit*. Fair boundary or emotional manipulation? Was he given a real chance to process what being "all in" means?
7. Should Ryder be spilling relationship tea to mafia insiders without getting the ok from Alessa first? Is it betrayal, concern, or just being messy AF?
8. Suddenly Gabe and Ryder get real once Leo's locked in. Is that jealousy kicking in, fear of losing her, or genuine emotional growth?
9. Could you have Alessa-level honesty in a poly setup, or would jealousy and fear wreck it? Where's the line between desire and disrespect?

10. Holden's moment is pure soft-boy swoon: dream car, dream girl, dream guy. How did this scene hit you? What would your dream trio be?

11. Alessa doesn't let anyone coddle her — even when bullets are flying. Boss move or reckless? Is she protecting her freedom or pushing people away?

## Aftercare - Final Thoughts

12. That stalker reveal — did you see it coming, or were you completely blindsided?
