Foreplay - Warm Up Questions

1. What's the overall spice level? 1 (Not Spicy) - 10 (Spiciest Thing I've Ever Read)?
2. How does the spice level compare to the other books we've read together?
3. Food is a love language — and Alessa's heart can be bribed with Ragu Alla Bolognese. What's the one dish that you'd ruin your morals for?

The Spicy Bits - Gettin' Down and Dirty with the Plot

4. That capture-and-escape sequence was pure chaos and trauma. Discuss what you might've tried during the escape.
5. Do you think it's right to invite Zane into the poly knowing how the guys feel about him? Is it an act of love or is it a betrayal?
6. Alessa's back in black — and back in control. What outfit makes you feel like you could run an empire and kill a man if needed?
7. Forced proximity, enemies to lovers, only-one-bed... Gage's teasing hits a little too close to your reading habits. What trope owns your soul?
8. Be honest: who did you suspect was the mole, and did you believe it all the way until the reveal? Were you shocked or vindicated?
9. What do you think of the huge shift in the relationship between Ryder and Zane?

10. Power play vs. domination — is there a difference between controlling someone and taking control from them? How does that land for you emotionally... and sexually?

11. Alessa's no stranger to control games — and edging is definitely on the table. Are you here for slow torture in the bedroom? Does it depend on who's in charge?
