Foreplay - Warm Up Questions

1. What's the overall spice level? 1 (Not Spicy) - 10 (Spiciest Thing I've Ever Read)?
2. How does the spice level compare to the other books we've read together?
3. "Lean into it." What's a phrase, mantra, or affirmation that helps you make bold (or risky) choices?

The Spicy Bits - Gettin' Down and Dirty with the Plot

4. What do you think about Dom and Val's whirlwind romance on the plane? Would you ever lean into an intense connection that fast? One drink, a little turbulence, and a lot of chemistry—what would you do?
5. Is it "sisters before misters" or is Val making the right call in Vegas?
6. What did you think of Dom's trick—playing her to gain access to something personal? Is deception forgivable if it ends in love? Or do you need a little more groveling before handing over your heart (and your phone number)?
7. Discuss when Val says no to the ring and ends up with a tattoo. Is the ring finger tattoo romantic? Would you ever get inked for love?
8. Dom's family situation explains a lot, but is it enough to excuse how he hurt Val? When someone is healing, how much grace do you give before your boundaries take over?
9. If you married into a wealthy family, would you keep working? Would you chase your passion no matter what—or become a stay-at-home flirt with a luxury

skincare routine and a secret project?

10. What's your comfort outfit—and what outfit makes you feel hot?

11. "He risked his life to protect mine. And that's what matters. Not how we started. Not his motivations. Not any of what happened before. What matters is what happens now. What happens next." Do you agree with Val's outlook on forgiveness and second chances—or does your version of closure look a little different?
