Foreplay - Warm Up Questions

2. How does the spice level compare to the other books we've read together?
3. Have you ever had a crush on someone from afar? Did it stay a fantasy, or did something ever actually happen?

The Spicy Bits - Gettin' Down and Dirty with the Plot

4. Do you love true crime? Do you enjoy stories where obsession meets danger—or does the line between hot and horrifying get a little blurry?
5. "I'm an overpacker. It's just who I am." What's something "extra" about you that you've stopped apologizing for—or something you're still learning to love?
6. Hans showing up in Mexico; is intense devotion romantic or red-flaggy when it involves tracking your every move?
7. What would you do if you were in Cassie's place - brought into a secret basement with a palm reading device. Would you be curious, suspicious, or fully turned on by the whole dark mystery vibe?
8. "It's like hearing a song for the first time after years and years but remembering every lyric the second it starts." How would you describe the moment you realize it's love—or lust disguised as love?
9. What's something ordinary or unusual that's deeply important to you? (Like Hans' obsession with post-it notes.)

10. What about the big reveal about Cassie's dad - did you expect it?

11. Discuss the female mercenary crew that Hans has helped build. Would you want to see a series about them?
