The Dirty Dozen

Foreplay - Warm Up Questions

1. What's the overall spice level? 1 (Not Spicy) - 10 (Spiciest Thing I've Ever Read)?
2. How does the spice level compare to the other books we've read together?
3. If you have a pet, what kind of conversations do you have through eye contact and blinks - like King and Duke? What do you think your pet would say if they saw your search history after reading this book?

The Spicy Bits - Gettin' Down and Dirty with the Plot

4. Do you think Aspen is fair to Savannah throughout the story—or does she project too much?
5. Savannah describes her puking as “evidence of my weakness.” Have you ever judged yourself too harshly in a vulnerable moment? And do you agree that softness = weakness?
6. What do you think of King snapping; does the grumpy protector trope do it for you, or do you prefer slow-simmer control?
7. Discuss the junkyard scene. Oh, you know the one.
8. Savannah feels like she's “too much” emotionally, physically, and in the way she moves through the world. Do you relate to that feeling? And do you think King helps her feel more seen or more fragile?
9. Do you think it's just Stockholm Syndrome gone wild, or does Savannah really come around to loving King despite her captivity?

10. How do you feel about a “touch her and die” trope? King threatens to remove eyeballs just for looking at his wife and all sorts; is that your yum?

11. We know King loves a rocket launcher. What would be your weapon of choice—fictional or real. If your partner showed up ready to defend your honor, what would their signature move be: sniper rifle, sledgehammer, or savage tongue?

12. If you had to pick one man to come ruin your emotional stability, who are you choosing—Nero or King—and why?

Bonus: What questions do you have for the author? If you could dog-ear a page with a question for the author, what would it be?
