Foreplay - Warm Up Questions

1. What's the overall spice level? 1 (Not Spicy) - 10 (Spiciest Thing I've Ever Read)?
2. How does the spice level compare to the other books we've read together?
3. How do you feel about a mafia trope? Is it hot or not?

The Spicy Bits - Gettin' Down and Dirty with the Plot

4. If a stranger broke in and he looked like Nero—dangerous, broody, ridiculously hot—would you run, scream, or let the scene play out?
5. What do you do when the man who broke into your house casually throws his arm around your shoulders on the couch? Does the audacity make it hotter? Would you shove him off, lean in, or pretend you're not wildly turned on?
6. Do you have an "in public" fantasy or fun story to share?
7. Are you into the way Nero speaks to Payton? Do you like a little dominance in your dirty talk—or does bossy banter kill the vibe for you?
8. How would you feel if someone did for you what Nero did for Payton with her stepdad? Would you be grateful... or terrified? Is vigilante justice romantic, or a red flag wrapped in a suit?
9. What do you think about instalove?
10. What is one thing you like about your body—or something your partner does that instantly gets you going?

11. If Nero were a mocktail, cocktail or specialty coffee, what would be in it? What would your personal spicy drink say about you?
