Welcome to our spicy book club resource page, where we turn the page to a whole new chapter of fun! Get ready to dive into a world of plot twists and character arcs as we leaf through our current book selection. We've provided the Dirty Dozen; twelve spicy and intriguing questions to spark discussion and help you uncover the spine-tingling depths of the story.

The Mindf*ck Series isn't really made to be read one book at a time. Each installment is short, and together they feel like one continuous story split into five parts. That's why we're giving you a Dirty Dozen Double Digest - aka the Titillating Twenty-Four - a full set of 24 questions that covers the entire series in one go.

The Titillating Twenty-Four

Foreplay - Warm Up Questions

1. What's the overall spice level? 1 (Not Spicy) - 10 (Spiciest Thing I've Ever Read)?
2. How does the spice level compare to the other books we've read together?
3. *"Einstein said, 'The weak revenge. The strong forgive. The intelligent ignore.' F*ck that. Einstein wasn't always right."* What do you think about this quote? Does it set the tone for Lana's version of justice?
4. *"If he'd seen the evil I've seen, he'd understand why some people deserve to die."* Do you agree with this justification for Lana's revenge?

The Spicy Bits - Gettin' Down and Dirty with the Plot

5. What's your take on the idea that law enforcement officers who repeatedly kill with intent are also serial killers?
6. *"Anything and everything will be forgiven if you have the right face."* Have you seen this play out in real life? Is it true in your experience?
7. What did you think when you figured out why the boots and rocks were in both packs, front and back?

8. Lana just wants one normal night with a normal guy. How impossible do you think that is when your life is built on secrets and death?
9. What do you think of the bystander effect? Are people truly indifferent, or are they just scared to intervene?
10. If your child went full Lana—stealing identities and funding revenge—what would you think? Proud? Horrified? Conflicted?
11. Would you be bold enough to date the biggest threat to your plan and your freedom?
12. Have you ever been jealous in a way that caught you off guard? Did it surprise you, like it surprised Logan?
13. *"To see and listen to the wicked is already the beginning of wickedness."* Discuss this quote. Does knowing someone's dark side make you complicit?
14. *"It feels good to crave someone and want them."* What makes you feel truly alive—emotionally or physically?
15. *"A past doesn't make a person."* Do you agree, or would you want to know everything about your partner's past before falling in deep?
16. Do you think Lana is a monster—or is that label something she uses to protect herself from judgment?
17. Do you enjoy all the quotes throughout the series? Did they deepen the meaning or feel overdone?
18. Is the girl Lana used to be still there underneath the blood and revenge? Or is she someone completely new?
19. What did you think of including POVs from other characters in later books? Did it add emotional depth or take you out of Lana's head?
20. Do you think Hadley made the right call in keeping Lana's secret from Logan?
21. Is Lana's ability to love what keeps her from becoming a complete villain, or does it make her even more dangerous?
22. *"Expectation is the root of all heartache."* Do you agree? What expectations have you had to let go of?

Aftercare - Final Thoughts

23. What did you think of who the original killer was? Were you shocked or had you figured it out?
24. Discuss the epilogue.
