The Dirty Dozen

Foreplay - Warm Up Questions

1. What's the overall spice level? 1 (Not Spicy) - 10 (Spiciest Thing I've Ever Read)?
2. How does the spice level compare to the other books we've read together?
3. Let's start with the ache before the burn. Have you ever opened up and asked for exactly what you wanted—emotionally, sexually, or otherwise—only to be shut down or judged? How did that moment shape your confidence or your kinks?

The Spicy Bits - Gettin' Down and Dirty with the Plot

4. What three things do you take as seriously as Garrett does his running, suits, and sex?
5. Step-sibling romance: hot taboo or hard pass? Did this dynamic work for you in the story, or did it push your comfort zone?
6. Let's talk pressure. Garrett carries a ton of it, from running the club to proving his worth. When have you felt like everything might fall apart without you—and what would it mean if it didn't?
7. What did you think of the cam girl vs. porn star that Reese claimed Mia was? Where do you draw the line between kink and judgment—and how do characters like Mia reclaim that power?
8. Were you surprised Mia was a virgin as a sex worker? Did her experience (or lack thereof) impact how you viewed her confidence and choices?

9. Let's hear it for angry sex and voyeurism. Why is having a safe, shame-free space for kinks so vital? Did the club deliver that fantasy for you?

10. *"Love isn't shit. It's not worth a damn thing. But time, attention, priority... those things are real, and until a man gives you those, don't give him the time of day, beautiful."* How do you feel about that distinction between love and real-life action? Did Garrett prove himself worthy in how he showed up?

11. If someone you loved lied about something huge for what they thought was a good reason... could you forgive them? Where's the line between protection and betrayal?

12. Self-sabotage and shame run deep in this book. What part of yourself or your past have you learned to love—even when it's messy?
