The Dirty Dozen

Foreplay - Warm Up Questions

1. What's the overall spice level? 1 (Not Spicy) - 10 (Spiciest Thing I've Ever Read)?
2. How does the spice level compare to the other books we've read together?
3. Have you ever felt a magnetic pull to someone the way Cillian and Dinara feel it—like you're being dragged under, even when you know it could ruin everything?

The Spicy Bits - Gettin' Down and Dirty with the Plot

4. Could you marry someone whose family had hurt yours? Could you set aside a legacy of betrayal for the sake of love—or lust?
5. After the breakup, do you think Dinara's friends treated her right, or were they just pouring salt in a wound they never truly understood?
6. Cillian breaks into her place, steals her things, and shows up uninvited. Is it possessive and powerful—or just plain toxic? Where's the line between dark romance and danger you'd actually run from?
7. Before the ending, who did you suspect caused the car accident? Were you onto the twist—or totally blindsided?
8. Dinara disappears to an Italian villa for four years. If you needed to go off-grid and heal, where would your dream hideaway be?
9. After all that time, Dinara still doesn't trust Cillian. Do you think that's fair, or should she have let herself fall again? Can trust ever be rebuilt after the kind of betrayal they went through?

10. Let's talk about this line: "We did what we could with what we had." Have you ever had to forgive yourself—or someone else—for past decisions that were made from a place of survival instead of strength?

11. Honeycake helps melt her defenses—but what would actually work to win you back after that kind of heartbreak? A grand gesture? Quiet consistency? Brutal honesty? Or is delicious cake enough?

12. If you've read all four books, which Savage King would you kneel for—and why? Is it the brutal one, the possessive one, the one who breaks the rules, or the one who breaks you open?
