Foreplay - Warm Up Questions

3. If you've read Priest, how do Sean and Tyler compare and contrast? Which Bell boy is more your type?

The Spicy Bits - Gettin' Down and Dirty with the Plot

4. Do you think Sean is doing the right thing by helping Zenny explore her doubts—or is it selfish and wrong?
5. Was the roller skating date what you expected? Did it change how you saw their relationship?
6. What did you think of Sean's admission that he feels useless and obsolete when people he loves lean on faith instead of him?
7. How did you feel about Sean's plan to "take his time" with Zenny; romantic, manipulative, or something in between?
8. Do you enjoy toys in romance novels (and real life)? Do you have a preference or recommendation?
9. What did you think of Sean's realization about the type of people he surrounds himself with?

10. How did the Iverson Bell family schism influence your view of Sean and his choices?

11. Was it selfish of Sean to go to Zenny right before her ceremony? Was he only thinking of himself—or was it a necessary moment?
