Foreplay - Warm Up Questions

2. How does the spice level compare to the other books we've read together?
3. Alright, let's settle this once and for all—do you prefer your fantasy men with anatomically ambitious proportions, or are you a realist who cringes at the logistics? Fantasy magic or real-world physics—what's your spicy preference?

The Spicy Bits - Gettin' Down and Dirty with the Plot

4. Dain's overprotective vibes—swoon-worthy guardian angel or red flag factory? Does Violet need a bodyguard or a restraining order?
5. The Marked Ones' secret meetup: Illegal doesn't always mean wrong, and legal doesn't always mean right. Where do you draw the line? Would you join the rebellion or snitch for extra credit?
6. *"Hope is a fickle, dangerous thing."* Is hope a sneaky little thief stealing your focus, or is it the only thing keeping you from yeeting yourself off a cliff?
7. *"The thought is too heavy to carry."* Have you ever had thoughts that felt too heavy to carry? What does that mean to you?

9. If you had to steal something to survive, what's your move? A weapon? Intel? Or just the hottest rider's dignity?

11. If you manifested a signet, would it be something cool (mind-reading, fire-wielding) or embarrassingly niche (always knowing when bread is perfectly toasted or lightning orgasms)?
