The Dirty Dozen

Foreplay - Warm Up Questions

1. What's the overall spice level? 1 (Not Spicy) - 10 (Spiciest Thing I've Ever Read)?
2. How does the spice level compare to the other books we've read together?
3. We've all been there—wanting to forgive, but our petty hearts just won't let us. Is your opinion that 'Violet Should Get Over It' or do you think 'Xaden Better Start Groveling on His Knees'? Spill the tea.

The Spicy Bits - Gettin' Down and Dirty with the Plot

4. "*Love is hope, and hope is harder to kill than a dragon.*" Bold statement or poetic BS? Is love really that unkillable, or has this woman never met your ex?
5. Should Xaden spill ALL the secrets now that he's leading the rebellion, or is "need-to-know basis" actually the smarter move? Full transparency or plausible deniability—what's your relationship philosophy?
6. Dragon riding = high chance of death. Would you patch things up before flying out, or just wing it and hope for the best?" (Pun intended.)
7. "*Kill Dain to save Xaden? No choice.*" But wait—both have betrayed her. Could you make that call, or would you let them both fight it out Thunderdome-style?
8. Do you agree with Violet's view that Xaden doesn't express how he feels about her, because he hasn't said the words, "I love you?"
9. Should Violet have told her squad about the Venin and Wyvern sooner, or was she right to keep it close to her chest?

10. Do you think Liam was just a hallucination, or a protective spirit or ghost? Why do you think Violet sees him, specifically, to support her during the torture?

11. *"I will not fucking die today"*—Violet's mantra. What's your go-to affirmation when life tries to end you?" Bonus points if it's unhinged.

Aftercare - Final Thoughts

12. Unforgivable offenses check: Violet's secrets, Brennan's lies, General Sorrengail's war crimes, Xaden's... everything. Who's crossed the point of no return for you?

If you had to pick one character to lock in a room with until they told the truth, who would it be?
