6. Would you have forgiven Junior so quickly for what happened in high school? And then again with the tracker? And then again with keeping her dad a secret? And on and on and on... how many chances would you give Junior?
7. Have you ever used "Cam girls" or been to a club like Velvet? Does it interest you?
8. What do you think about the gray world of the Mafia as described by Lauren?
9. Do you think Junior did the right thing, even though it was against club rules to keep everyone safe?
10. Could you have done it in a confessional? Have you ever had to stay totally silent?

11. Could you handle dating someone whose work is all about desire and boundaries, like sex workers? How would it affect trust, intimacy, and your own comfort levels?
