Foreplay - Warm Up Questions

1. What's the overall spice level? 1 (Not Spicy) - 10 (Spiciest Thing I've Ever Read)?
2. How does the spice level compare to the other books we've read together?
3. Nick refuses to market something that might make people lonelier. Was that the right moral stand, or a bit over the top?

The Spicy Bits - Gettin' Down and Dirty with the Plot

4. Fake dating gives them cover but also stirs up tension. Do you think fake dating ever makes sense in real life, or would it just be a messy disaster?
5. Yellow roses instead of pink or white is proof that Julie's ex never really paid attention. Do you think knowing (and remembering) little details like someone's favorite flower is essential in love, or just a bonus?
6. Elaborate PowerPoint with fake dating plans: genius touch or way too weird? Would you be impressed or immediately run?
7. It felt like Julie could've - or maybe should've - blocked Craig sooner. When an ex sends texts saying, "can't stand knowing you're with someone else," would you block them without hesitation, or secretly enjoy the ego boost?
8. Body shots top their list of wild experiences. What would make your own spicy bucket list and what's already been checked off?
9. When their clothes get stolen and Julie's panties pocketed, she's furious. Would you have stormed in to announce yourself, or laughed it off and rolled with the

chaos?

10. After just six days of fake dating, Nick admits it feels like more. Could you actually fall in love in less than a week or is that only believable in fiction?

11. With celebrity status complicating things, would you ever date someone famous knowing the spotlight and gossip would be nonstop?
