Foreplay - Warm Up Questions

2. How does the spice level compare to the other books we've read together?
3. How would you feel about living in a town where every day was basically Halloween? Would it feel magical or a bit too much?

4. Have you ever uprooted your life for a fresh start and, if so, did it feel more like escape or opportunity?
5. If someone kissed you within fifteen minutes of meeting, would you lean in and join them, or shove them away for crossing the line?
6. What did you think of Lydia and Harrison's first interactions? Was their immediate chemistry believable, or did it feel too familiar too fast?
7. Do you think Lydia and Harrison's bond was forged more from passion, circumstance, or genuine destiny? Which of those makes a stronger foundation for love?

8. If your entire identity (as a shifter, witch, or otherwise) was stripped away, how would you rebuild yourself?
