The Dirty Dozen

Foreplay - Warm Up Questions

1. What's the overall spice level? 1 (Not Spicy) - 10 (Spiciest Thing I've Ever Read)?
2. How does the spice level compare to the other books we've read together?
3. Do you think Emma's optimism about her future with Chandler is genuine, or is she trying to convince herself? Have you ever seen someone get swept up in "the plan" instead of the person?

The Spicy Bits - Gettin' Down and Dirty with the Plot

4. Did you sense the chemistry between them from the start, or were you surprised by the slow reveal of their past? When do you think the emotional tension tipped into something undeniable?
5. Is this book making a case for joy and playfulness over planning? How does Theo's approach to life and energy contrast with Laney's initial state?
6. Is brutal honesty sexy? Would you rather have a partner who makes dumb choices but owns them, or someone who plays it safe but withholds the truth?
7. Everyone needs a Sabrina, but could you handle a Sabrina? Where's the line between tough love and just plain rude?
8. When Theo's secret job is revealed, could you be with a partner who makes that kind of content? Would it be a hard limit, or are you open to it if there's trust and honesty? What would make it a turn-on or a total deal-breaker?

9. *"I want him because he's life."* This is a full-body, soul-level attraction. When was the moment you fell for Theo—or Laney? Did this feel like lust, love, or something even riskier?

10. The Chocolate Chip Cookies. Sensory overload: food, feelings, and desire. What non-sexual moment in the book felt the most intimate to you?

11. Laney tried to logic her way into a mediocre relationship with Christopher. Have you ever had a "we'll be happy once..." spiral? How do you recognize when love isn't enough—or never was?

Aftercare - Final Thoughts

12. What does this story say about taking risks in love? Did Laney and Theo earn their happily ever after (HEA) and would you have made the same leap?

Bonus: What questions do you have for the author? If you could dog-ear a page with a question for the author, what would it be?
