The Dirty Dozen

Foreplay - Warm Up Questions

1. What's the overall spice level? 1 (Not Spicy) - 10 (Spiciest Thing I've Ever Read)?
2. How does the spice level compare to the other books we've read together?
3. Younger Autumn once dreamed of more than her teenage job, but as an adult she's stuck in the same place. Looking back, what did you dream of as a teen, and how do those hopes compare to where you are now?

The Spicy Bits - Gettin' Down and Dirty with the Plot

4. Autumn doesn't believe in everlasting love, but romance novels thrive on the promise of it. Do you think "happily ever after" is a requirement for love stories - or for love itself?
5. That locked, mysterious house with ghost rumors sets a gothic tone. Do you think curiosity would drive you to open that forbidden door, or would you leave the mystery intact?
6. Zane uses the 5-4-3-2-1 method to fight off anxiety. What's a coping strategy you've tried in moments of overwhelm, and does it work for you?
7. A misfired, horny text creates both humor and heat. What's the most embarrassing or memorable message you've ever sent (or received) by accident?
8. Autumn whispers that seeing Zane feels like magic, as if he's both dream and reality colliding. Have you ever had a moment with someone that felt otherworldly, almost too good to be real?

9. Autumn claims “nothing is ever coincidental.” Do you believe in fate, signs, or the universe pushing people together, or is it all just random chance?

10. When Autumn realizes her ex sent her a dress, the boundaries between past and present relationships blur. How would you react if an ex inserted themselves into your new relationship like that?

11. “You can only control yourself, no one else.” Autumn’s reminder is both wise and difficult. Do you agree love means accepting both the good and bad in someone, or do you believe in drawing firm lines?

Aftercare - Final Thoughts

12. By the end, Zane and Autumn risk it all to be together. Do you think their love feels like a reckless fall or a necessary leap—and would you take that kind of risk for someone?
