The Dirty Dozen

Foreplay - Warm Up Questions

1. What's the overall spice level? 1 (Not Spicy) - 10 (Spiciest Thing I've Ever Read)?
2. How does the spice level compare to the other books we've read together?
3. Ella/Holly blurs the lines between performance and authenticity. Have you ever found yourself acting as "someone else" in order to feel braver, bolder, or freer?

The Spicy Bits - Gettin' Down and Dirty with the Plot

4. Holly openly embraces the idea of being watched, even craved. Did the exhibitionist streak heighten the intensity for you, or make you pull back?
5. The book digs into sex work and emotional attachment. Could you separate love from the job the way Ella struggles to, or would feelings inevitably bleed through?
6. When Josh declares, "I'm not her pimp. I'm her fucking boyfriend," did you swoon at the claim of ownership/protection, or did it raise red flags?
7. What would you have done when Carly and Connor turned up at family dinner?
8. Sixty grand is on the table, but the act itself is brutal and degrading. Would you take the money and endure the pain, or is there no price worth that kind of experience?
9. Many people judge sex workers while secretly consuming their services. Did the book make you rethink double standards around shame, desire, and respect?

10. Discuss what Connor does when telling Ella's family about her job. Do you think they were right to jump on the plane early, or should they have waited it out until they were scheduled to arrive to hear her side of the story? Could you tell your parents if you became a sex worker?

11. Do you agree that compassion is a stronger asset than resentment, or do you think hate can sometimes be the fuel a person needs to survive and fight back?

Aftercare - Final Thoughts

12. What did you think of the surprise of Heath towards the end of the book? Are you ready to hear about their Naughty Week together?

Bonus: What questions do you have for the author? If you could dog-ear a page with a question for the author, what would it be?
