## The Dirty Dozen

### Foreplay - Warm Up Questions

1. What's the overall spice level? 1 (Not Spicy) - 10 (Spiciest Thing I've Ever Read)?
2. How does the spice level compare to the other books we've read together?
3. Have you ever found yourself accepting "crumbs" in a relationship, thinking it was love? How did you realize you deserved more?

### The Spicy Bits - Gettin' Down and Dirty with the Plot

4. Would you have waited as long as Madi did for a relationship to move forward without a clear next step?
5. Who in your life has been a "Gigi" for you? Someone who fixes things out of love and truly knows you?
6. Where's the one place you can let every guard down - no bra, no filter, no pretending?
7. Do you think life really smiles back when you smile at it, or does it need more of a wink, a shot of tequila, and maybe a little grinding on the dance floor?
8. When you're upset, do you crack jokes and hide behind humor like Madi? Or are you more of a scream-into-a-pillow, cry-in-the-shower, or set-things-on-fire type?
9. Which look makes your ovaries (or equivalent) cheer louder: a fireman in turnout gear, a man in a tux, an athlete mid-game, a soldier in uniform, or a sexy nerd rocking a sweater vest?

10. Ross and Hannah carried on an eight-month emotional affair—do you think that's worse than a quick physical fling, or would you rather deal with the body than the heart?

11. Be honest: if your pets are in the room when things get heated, are you the type to kick them out, let them stay, or pretend you don't notice the judgmental stare?
