Foreplay - Warm Up Questions

1. What's the overall spice level? 1 (Not Spicy) - 10 (Spiciest Thing I've Ever Read)?
2. How does the spice level compare to the other books we've read together?
3. Gut instincts or data-driven decisions: which rules you?

The Spicy Bits - Gettin' Down and Dirty with the Plot

4. A listing full of rules to keep people away — take the house, or dodge the drama?
5. Imagine unloading your deepest secrets to a total stranger... only to find out he's your new landlord. Are you dying of mortification or leaning into the chaos?
6. Claire feels “too soft and too hard” for the world and it also resonates with Levi. How do you protect your heart without losing the parts of yourself that feel things deeply?
7. Are you the “deep dive until I know everything” kind of nerd or the “jack of all trades, master of vibes” type? When curiosity strikes — are you a relentless question-asker like Claire, or do you chill until something really juicy comes along?
8. So... what would you do if you got caught mid-bath-time solo session? Panic? Own it? Invite him to grab a towel?
9. Levi uses art to reveal truth. What's your personal outlet for honesty - the thing that lets you show who you are without saying a word?

10. There's something intoxicating about being truly admired, not just for looks, but for how your mind works. What kind of compliment makes you melt?

11. Dirty Talk. Are you into it or is it a hard pass?

12. Claire faces the leap-or-retreat moment with Levi. When emotions run high, are you the one who dives all in or the one who takes a cautious step back?
