### Foreplay - Warm Up Questions

1. What's the overall spice level? 1 (Not Spicy) - 10 (Spiciest Thing I've Ever Read)?
2. How does the spice level compare to the other books we've read together?
3. Emily fights for a "better life," even if it means starting small. Have you ever had your own "getting out" moment - breaking free from something and starting fresh?

### The Spicy Bits - Gettin' Down and Dirty with the Plot

4. When someone says "words are just words, it's the actions that matter," do you agree, or do words hold their own kind of power in intimacy and relationships?
5. If you woke up one morning as a vegetable, what would you be, and how would you use that new form to your advantage?
6. Robert questions why God would make personhood so complicated and morality so unclear. Do you think life is meant to be this messy and open to interpretation, or is that just an excuse humans use to bend the rules?
7. The three-way confession of love is the key to freedom. Do you think true love can exist in threes (or more), or is that just fantasy logic?

8. Religion, morality, shapeshifting veggies: it's all a mess. Did you find any healing of your own religious trauma?
