Foreplay - Warm Up Questions

1. What's the overall spice level? 1 (Not Spicy) - 10 (Spiciest Thing I've Ever Read)?
2. How does the spice level compare to the other books we've read together?
3. Hallmark movies: hot or not? If you were the heroine of your own obscene holiday romcom, what job would you have that definitely wouldn't pay the bills but would make you look adorable in knitwear?

The Spicy Bits - Gettin' Down and Dirty with the Plot

4. Based on how Cole, Jace, Alec, and Reed are described early on, who would you pick first if you were drafting your own Christmas "team roster," and what's your reasoning - pure lust, vibes, actions, or all three?
5. Samantha calls Priest (by Sierra Simone) "spiritual self-care" (true). What's a book that you personally consider holy scripture for your libido, and why does it spiritually slap?
6. When someone you're into growls "trust me" and takes control... are you the type to ask clarifying questions first, or do you just strip and say, "Guess we're doing this now"?
7. At the point where her heart's racing with excitement, what sexy plan would you want the guys to spring on you? Something sweet and teasing, something filthy and coordinated, or something that would require a safe word and a stretch first?
