Foreplay - Warm Up Questions

1. What's the overall spice level? 1 (Not Spicy) - 10 (Spiciest Thing I've Ever Read)?
2. How does the spice level compare to the other books we've read together?
3. The coffee machine line sets the tone for humor and obsession. What's the quirkiest, most ridiculous "everyday object crush" you've ever had?

The Spicy Bits - Gettin' Down and Dirty with the Plot

4. Would you ever be bold enough to ask for something as explicit as "suck on my nipples until I scream for mercy"? Or do you prefer your desires to be discovered without asking?
5. Is Mina's mom just a selfish opportunist, or does she actually have ambition and hustle worth respecting?
6. That moment of possessiveness with wanting to stake your claim on someone in public; have you ever felt that primal surge? How did you handle it?
7. The "hardest path" conversation is really about navigating a polyamorous relationship. Do you think the struggle makes that kind of love stronger and more intentional, or is it just a way to avoid admitting how vulnerable it feels to love more than one person?
8. Imagine the "grandmother plot twist." How would you react if your family revealed a hidden, supernatural secret about themselves?

9. If a character could leave their own story and become real, which one from your favorite books would you choose to cross over? What kind of chaos (or pleasure) would they bring to your world?

10. In the heat of the moment, Morrie promises no sleeping at all. What's your ultimate fantasy getaway or bedroom setup, and which fictional (or real) lovers would you stock it with?

11. When Beverly confronts Angus and it's revealed he's the real threat, did you see it coming? What clues tipped you off, or were you completely blindsided by the killer being under our noses all along?
