Foreplay - Warm Up Questions

2. How does the spice level compare to the other books we've read together?
3. If you were stuck sharing one bed in a house that kept shifting between time periods, would you stay the night? And which era would you secretly hope it shifted to?

The Spicy Bits - Gettin' Down and Dirty with the Plot

4. Lydia diving headfirst into social media is comedy gold. What's the first modern thing you'd corrupt her with, and why?
5. Be honest: have you ever gotten an unsolicited pic? Did you block, laugh, save, or fire one back?
6. Time to play: Between Morrie, Heathcliff and Quoth from the book would you f*ck, marry, kill? Defend your choices.
7. If it really came down to it, who would you choose in a "why choose" situation? Could you actually pick one, or would you demand the full buffet?
8. Morrie calls love "wild, maddening, dangerous passion." Do you see love as chaos, comfort, or both? Which version is playing out in this trio?
9. Mina bartering affection for sex ("say you love me, then you get my ass") — hot power move or toxic manipulation?

10. Could you honestly resist getting involved if you knew you were standing toe-to-toe with a murderer, or would curiosity and adrenaline win?

11. If you had to live out your own dark romance arc, would you play cop or criminal, and which role do you think would really suit you?
