The Dirty Dozen

Foreplay - Warm Up Questions

1. What's the overall spice level? 1 (Not Spicy) - 10 (Spiciest Thing I've Ever Read)?
2. How does the spice level compare to the other books we've read together?
3. If your dad did you like Collin did Jessa (ignored your existence except for meeting you once or twice and giving you \$15,000), would you have gone to the funeral?

The Spicy Bits - Gettin' Down and Dirty with the Plot

4. Jessa ends up accepting a lot after the funeral - a house, shares in the business, a job, and a drunken ride home. Would you have done this? Is it the very least she's owed in a new town or should she be standing on her own two feet?
5. Loneliness makes affection feel radioactive in this story. Have you ever wanted touch or attention so badly that you acted in a way you normally wouldn't?
6. Being with someone famous or publicly adored: would the attention turn you on, make you jealous, or quietly exhaust you?
7. Imagine being caught on a kiss cam with someone you're secretly craving. Do you freeze, play it safe with a peck on the cheek, or put yourself out there for the world - and your crush - to see?
8. At what point does "they're tempting me" stop being an excuse and start being mutual responsibility, especially when desire keeps crossing lines?

9. When do you think it's time to talk about kinks and sexual compatibility: before the first date, after chemistry is established on the date, or only once feelings are real?

10. Does the Dom/sub dynamic that Aiden and Jessa share interest you? Are you a control freak, or do you want it all taken away where you can sink into sub space and be carried away with just the feelings of your body?

11. Jessa is fine with public exhibition at the club, but doesn't like his brothers seeing their cuddling. She also loves that he gets his c*ck out at the club, but that's the only part that anyone at the club gets to see; the rest of his body is just for her. Do you agree with her perspective or does it feel topsy-turvy to your ideas about sex and intimacy?
